

Civilian firearm possession in Ukraine since the Russian invasion




Relatively few people have firearms, but many more would like to have one

Access, however, is perceived to be much more difficult since the full scale invasion




The majority of respondents favour stricter regulations around firearm possession

Percentage of respondents who somewhat agree or completely agree with the below statements:





Many Ukrainians, especially men, have undergone some form of firearm training

The Unified Register of Weapons (URW)

* completely agree + rather agree


Some clear gaps in firearm storage practices remain

Respondents who have weapons in the household, or at least occasionally keep their firearm at home or in their vehicle



Less than 6 in 10 respondents living in firearmowning households declared that all their firearms are registered in the URW. About a quarter are not aware of the URW.

Are any of the firearms in this household* recorded in the Unified Register of Weapons?




